Anniversary screening of Balibo

Friday 16 October

October 16th 2015 marks the anniversary of the deaths of the Balibo Five in 1975.

This dramatic retelling of events follows five journalists captured and killed at Balibo in East Timor 40 years ago.

Thanks to an initiative by the film's director, Robert Connelly, we are holding this special memorial screening simultaneously with the Astor in Melbourne and in Hobart, with a share of the box office from the screenings going to East Timorese charity organisations.

Before the sun sets on another season of Deckchair, join us for one last hurrah.
























Irrational Man (M) 95m
