Brides (PG) 128m 2005, Pantelis Voulgaris, Greece 24 May In 1922, 700 Greek, Turkish, Russian

and Armenian mail-order brides are on a ship bound for New York bound and their new husbands. A glimpse into European heritage and one of the highest grossing films in Greece ever.

Committed (UC18+) 90m 2014, Stelana Kliris, Greece 23 May

George is under pressure to marry his girlfriend when he picks up a whimsical and free spirited hitchhiker in a wedding dress and their impromptu road trip changes him forever. Greek with English

God Help the Girl (M) 110m 2014, Stuart Murdoch, Nana Eksytimishvili, UK

Jodorowsky's Dune (M) 90m 2014, Franks Pavich, USA 17 & 29 May

For Dune die-hards, a documentary tribute to filmmaker Alejandro Jodorowsky and his unrealised adaptation of the sci-fi classic, so diabolically imaginative and unprecedented in its artistry, it was completely un-filmable.

Maya the Bee Movie (G) 84m 2014, Aleks Stadermann, Australia 10 & 22 May

An Australian adaptation of the German animated TV series. Maya is fed up with hive hierarchy and decides to explore the world outside, encountering friends and foes along the way.

Mr Turner (M) 150m 2014, Mike Leigh, UK 28 Apr & 2 May

Considered one of the greatest painters in British history, this complexly drawn biopic describes JMW Turner's rise to fame and fall from grace among Britain's conservative aristocracy in the nineteenth century.

Paper Planes (G) 96m 2014, Robert Connolly, Australia 19, 25 Apr & 4 May

The Water Diviner (M) 111m 2014, Russell Crowe, Australia 16 & 25 Apr

Those Happy Years (M) 100m 2014, Daniele Lucheti, Italy 3 May
