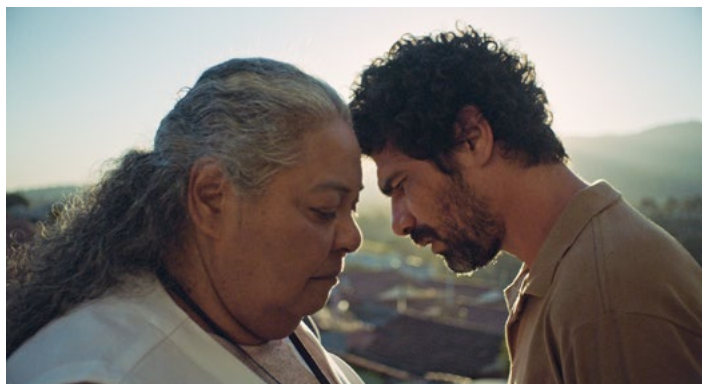

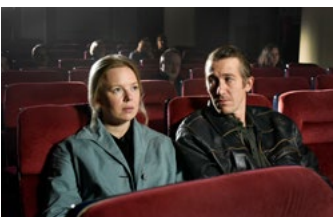
Poor Things

Fallen Leaves

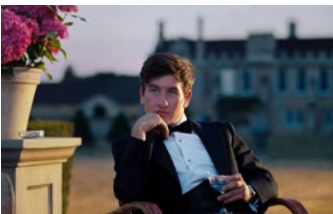

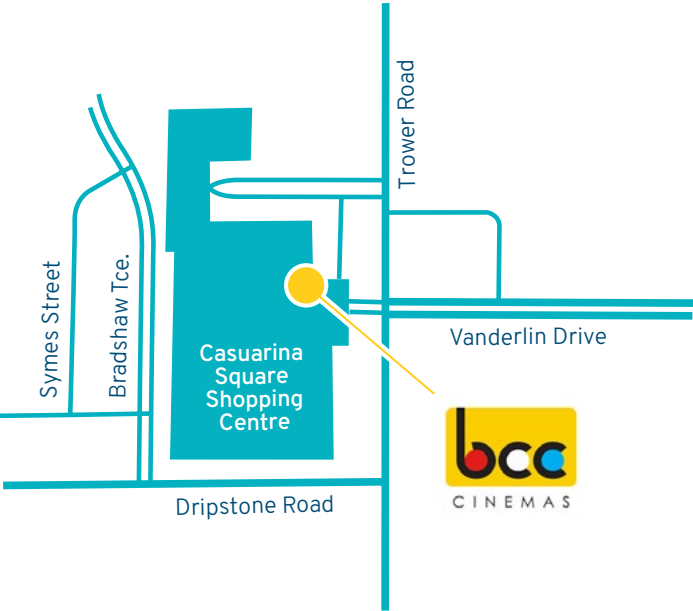
Theater Camp
