### TENOR (M) 101min

*Comedy, Drama, Music. Dir: Claude Zidi Jr. France. English subtitles.* Antoine, an aspiring young rapper from the suburbs of Paris, meets Mrs Loyseau, an eminent teacher at the Paris Opéra. Stunned by Antoine's raw talent, Mrs Loyseau takes him on as a student. But he hides his new dream from his friends and family, fearing that they won't understand. Somehow, Antoine will have to find his own voice. **January 1**

### THE OLD OAK (MA15+) 113min

*Drama. Dir: Ken Loach. UK.* The Old Oak, a local pub, stands as the last community gathering place in an impoverished town in the north of England. Publican TJ is struggling to make ends meet. Things change when an influx of Syrian refugees fuels xenophobic backlash across the township, and TJ steps up to help the newcomers. Rumoured to be the final film from revered filmmaker Ken Loach. **January 6, 7, 8**

### COUP DE CHANCE (STROKE OF LUCK) (PG) 96min

*Comedy, Drama, Romance. Dir: Woody Allen. USA, France. English subtitles.* Fanny and Jean are the ideal couple: fulfilled in their professional lives, they live in a magnificent apartment in the high-end districts of Paris and seem to be as in love as the first day they met. But when Fanny accidentally bumps into a former high school classmate, she's swept off her feet. Woody Allen's funniest film in years, full of charm and sparkle. **January 18, 22, 28**

### THE BOYS IN THE BOAT (CTC) 124min

*Biog, Drama, Sport. Dir: George Clooney. USA.* The inspirational true story of the 1936 University of Washington rowing team that competed for gold at the Summer Olympics in Berlin. It follows the group of underdogs at the height of the Great Depression as they take on elite rivals from around the world. Based on the #1 New York Times bestselling non-fiction novel written by Daniel James Brown. **January 20, 21, 24, 25, 27, 28**

### FLASHDANCE (1983, M) 92min

*Music, Romance, Drama. Dir: Adrian Lyne. USA.* Don your legwarmers... Alex Owens (Jennifer Beals) works a day job in a steel mill and dances in a bar at night. When she discovers that her boss Nick is both interested in her and supportive of her performing career, she renews her efforts to get accepted into a prestigious dance conservatory. Although Alex is frightened of failure, she is cheered on by Nick. **January 2**

### HIGH FIDELITY (2000, M) 113min

*Music, Romance, Drama. Dir: Stephen Frears. UK, USA.* Rob (John Cusack) is the owner of a failing record store in Chicago. His encyclopedic knowledge of pop music is of no help to him as his needle skips the love groove and his long-time girlfriend walks out on him. As he examines his failed attempts at romance and happiness, the process finds him being dragged, kicking and screaming, into adulthood. **January 16**

### NAPOLEON (MA15+) 158min

*Action, Adventure, Biography. Dir: Ridley Scott. USA, UK.* Details the checkered rise and fall of iconic French Emperor Napoleon Bonaparte (Joaquin Phoenix). It captures his relentless journey to power through the prism of his addictive, volatile relationship with his one true love, Josephine. It showcases his visionary military and political tactics against some of the most dynamic practical battle sequences ever filmed. **January 3, 7**



### MASTER GARDENER (M) 111min

*Drama, Mystery, Thriller. Dir: Paul Schrader. USA.* Narel Roth (Joel Edgerton) is the meticulous horticulturist of Gracewood Gardens, pandering to his employer, the wealthy dowager Mrs Haverhill (Sigourney Weaver). Chaos enters his spartan existence when Mrs Haverhill demands that he take on her wayward and troubled great-niece Maya as a new apprentice, unlocking dark secrets from a buried past that threaten them all. **January 4, 5, 6, 7, 10**

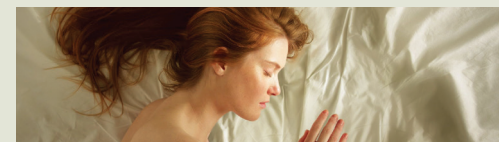

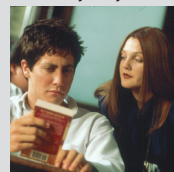

### DONNIE DARKO (2001, M) 113min

*Drama, Mystery. Dir: Richard Kelly. USA.* In a funny, moving and distinctly mind-bending journey through suburban America, one extraordinary but disenchanted teenager is about to take Time's Arrow for a ride. After surviving a freak accident, Donnie (Jake Gyllenhaal) begins to explore what it means to be alive and in love, when he uncovers secrets of the universe that give him a tempting power to alter time and destiny. **January 23**



### WONKA (PG) 116min

*Adventure, Comedy, Family. Dir: Paul King. USA, UK.* Based on the central character of Roald Dahl's most iconic children's book. An intoxicating mix of magic and music, mayhem and emotion, all told with heart and humor. We meet a young Willy Wonka (Timothée Chalamet), full of ideas and determined to change the world, one delectable bite at a time. 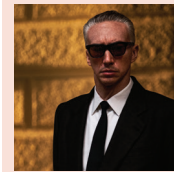
### MEAN GIRLS (CTC) 110min

*Comedy, Drama, Music. Dirs: Samantha Jayne, Arturo Perez Jr. USA.* From the comedic mind of Tina Fey comes a new twist on the modern classic. New student Cady Heron is welcomed into the top of the social food chain by the elite group of popular girls called Theastics. 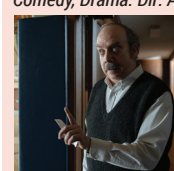
### FERRARI (MA15+) 130min

*Biog, Drama, History. Dir: Michael Mann. USA, UK, Italy.* During the summer of 1957, ex-racer Enzo Ferrari (Adam Driver) is in crisis. Bankruptcy stalks his company. His marriage struggles with the mourning for their only son and Enzo's romantic entanglement with another woman. Enzo is on the verge of losing everything and must wager it all on one race, the treacherous 1,000-mile race across Italy, the iconic Mille Miglia. **January 19, 20, 21, 26, 27, 29**



### THE HOLDOVERS (CTC) 133min

*Comedy, Drama. Dir: Alexander Payne. USA.* Nobody likes teacher Paul Hunham (Paul Giamatti) – not his students, his fellow faculty, nor the headmaster. With no family and nowhere to go over Christmas in 1970, Paul remains at school to supervise students unable to journey home. Paul, a trouble-making 15-year-old named Angus and head cook Mary form an unlikely Christmas family who share comic misadventures. **January 26, 27, 28, 31**



### BIG (1988, PG) 104min

*Comedy, Drama, Fantasy. Dir: Penny Marshall. USA.* After a wish turns 12-year-old Josh into a 30-year-old man (Tom Hanks), he heads to New York City and gets a low-level job at MacMillan Toy Company. A chance encounter with the owner leads to a promotion testing new toys. When fellow employee, Susan (Elizabeth Perkins), takes an interest in Josh, the pressure of living as an adult begins to overwhelm him, and he longs to return to his life as a boy. **January 9**



### LADIES IN LAVENDER (2004, M) 104min

*Music, Romance, Drama. Dir: Charles Dance. UK.* Aging spinster sisters Ursula (Judi Dench) and Janet (Maggie Smith) discover a young man near death on the beach by their home in a small Cornish fishing village. They discover he is a violinist from Poland, who had been swept off an ocean liner on the way to a fresh start in America. Ursula's unfamiliar spark of infatuation for the handsome young musician must remain unspoken. **January 30**
