ANYONE BUT YOU After an amazing first date, Bea and Ben's fiery attraction turns ice cold - until they find themselves unexpectedly reunited at a destination wedding in Australia. So they do what any two mature adults would do: pretend to be a couple.

FERRARI (R16) The movie is set during the summer of 1957. Ex-racecar driver, Ferrari, is in crisis. Bankruptcy stalks the company he and his wife, Laura, built from nothing ten years earlier. Their tempestuous marriage struggles with the mourning for one son and the acknowledgement of another. He decides to counter his losses by rolling the dice on one race – 1,000 miles across Italy, the iconic Mille Miglia

LIFE ON DENNISTON PLATEAU (E) On the West Coast of New Zealand on the wind-swept Denniston Plateau where neither gardens nor graves could be dug, the Westport Coal Company developed collieries and began building houses for mining families in the late C19th. In search of a better life in a new land, skilled British, Scots and Welsh mineworkers arrived to work the coal and established a number of vibrant communities. All the communities are gone now but the fellowship and good times remain in the memories of many of the folk who grew up and worked on The Hill. In Life on Denniston Plateau, they tell their stories.

MEAN GIRLS (M) From the comedic mind of Tina Fey comes a new twist on the modern classic, MEAN GIRLS. New student Cady Heron (Angourie Rice) is welcomed into the top of the social food chain by the elite group of popular girls called "The Plastics," ruled by the conniving queen bee Regina George (Reneé Rapp) and her minions Gretchen (Bebe Wood) and Karen (Avantika). However, when Cady makes the major misstep of falling for Regina's ex-boyfriend Aaron Samuels (Christopher Briney), she finds herself prey in Regina's crosshairs. As Cady sets to take down the group's apex predator with the help of her outcast friends Janis (Auli'i Cravalho) and Damian (Jaquel Spivey), she must learn how to stay true to herself while navigating the most cutthroat jungle of all: high school

MIGRATION (PG) A family of ducks try to convince their overprotective father to go on the vacation of a lifetime!

NIGHT SWIM (M) No running. No diving. No lifeguard on duty. No swimming after dark. Aomic Monster and Blumhouse, the producers of M3GAN, high dive into the deep end of horror with the new supernatural thriller, Night Swim.

ONE LIFE (PG) Follows British humanitarian Nicholas Winton, who helped save hundreds of Central European children from the Nazis on the eve of World War II. Anthony Hopkins and Helen Bonham Carter

PERFECT DAYS (M) Hirayama works as a toilet cleaner in Tokyo. He seems content with his simple life. He follows a structured everyday life and dedicates his free time to his passion for music and books. Hirayama also has a fondness for trees and photographs them. More of his past is gradually revealed through a series of unexpected encounters.

POOR THINGS (R18) From filmmaker Yorgos Lanthimos and producer Emma Stone comes the incredible tale and fantastical evolution of Bella Baxter (Stone), a young woman brought back to life by the brilliant and unorthodox scientist Dr. Godwin Baxter (Willem Dafoe). Under Baxter's protection, Bella is eager to learn. Hungry for the worldliness she is lacking, Bella runs off with Duncan Wedderburn (Mark Ruffalo), a slick and debauched lawyer, on a whirlwind adventure across the continents.

THE ABYSS –SPECIAL EDITION (M) A civilian diving team is enlisted to search for a lost nuclear submarine and faces danger while encountering an alien aquatic species.

THE BEEKEEPER (R16) The fast-paced action-thriller, which is steeped in the mythology of beekeeping, follows a man's personal journey of vengeance which takes on national stakes.

THE BOYS IN THE BOAT (M) Based on the non-fiction novel about the 1936 University of Washington rowing team that competed for gold at the 1936 Berlin Olympic games, this true story follows a group of underdogs at the height of the Great Depression as they're thrust into the spotlight and take on elite international rivals.

THE CANTERVILLE GHOST (PG) An American family moves in to Canterville Chase, a stately countryside mansion that has been haunted by the ghost Sir Simon De Canterville for 300 years.

THE CASTLE (M) AUSTRALIA DAY SPECIAL A Melbourne family is very happy living where they do, near the Melbourne airport (according to Jane Kennedy, it's "practically their back yard"). However, they are forced to leave their beloved home, by the Government and airport authorities. 'The Castle' is the story of how they fight to remain in their house, taking their case as far as the High Court
