## THE BEEKEEPER | R16 | VIOLENCE, OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE, DRUG USE & SUICIDE | 105 MINS |

Jason Statham stars in this, fast-paced action-thriller, which is steeped in the mythology of beekeeping, follows a man's personal journey of vengeance which takes on national stakes after he is revealed to be a former operative of a powerful and clandestine organization known as the 'Beekeepers'.

#### THE CANTERVILLE GHOST | PG | VIOLENCE & SCARY SCENES | 89 MINS |

In this adaptation of Oscar Wilde's classic children's story, the ghost of Sir Simon Canterville (Stephen Fry) has been roaming his castle for centuries, searching for a descendant who can release him from his curse by performing a brave deed. The only problem is – he keeps scaring them away.

Finally, a family move in who refuse to be startled, and Sir Simon is able to tell his tale to the inquisitive and courageous Virgina (Emily Carey). Can the two of them survive The Ghost Catcher (Miranda Hart), and The Reverend (Toby Jones), to bring balance to the house and set Sir Simon free?

#### THE HOLDOVERS | M | OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE | 133 MINS |
