Based on a true story, one woman fights for the equality, health, and happiness of immigrant orphans. From award-winning director Alejandro Monteverde comes the powerful, inspiring, true-life epic of an audacious young Italian woman who came to New York with nothing – and went on to become one the greatest entrepreneurs America has ever produced. Cabrini charts the rise of a hero for our time – a woman whose determination, business skill and unswerving faith helped her overcome profound sexism and anti-immigrant bigotry – all to found an empire of hope that transformed the lives of millions worldwide.

DUNE: PART TWO | M | VIOLENCE | 165 MINS | Sci-fi/Adventure

In the second part of Denis Villeneuve's adaptation of author Frank Herbert's classic science fiction epic, Duke Paul Atreides joins the Fremen and begins a spiritual and martial journey to become Muad'dib, while trying to prevent the horrible but inevitable future he's witnessed: a Holy War in his name, spreading throughout the known universe.

When Jessica returns to her childhood home with her family, she finds her old stuffed bear, Chauncey, and that her stepdaughter Alice has grown attached to it. After Alice's behavior becomes concerning and the games that she and Chauncey play turn increasingly sinister, Jessica starts realizing that Chauncey is much more than the stuffed bear she believed him to be for all those years.

THE CONVERT | **R13** | BLOODY VIOLENCE & CRUELTY | 119 MINS | Action and Drama

Guy Pearce leads this historical drama from director Lee Tamahori (Once Were Warriors) as lay preacher Thomas Munro in 1830s Aotearoa New Zealand. Arriving at a British settlement, his violent past is then drawn into question and his mission put to the test as he finds himself caught in the middle of a generational blood feud between Māori tribes. Co-stars Tioreore Ngatai-Melbourne (Whina), Antonio Te Maioha (Waru), Lawrence Makoare (The Dead Lands), Jacqueline McKenzie (Savage River) and Dean O'Gorman (Pork Pie).

The great Michael Caine stars in this British feature inspired by the true story of Bernard Jordan who, in 2014, escaped from his care home to attend the 70th Anniversary of the D-Day Landings in France.
